Part 1

Double portion blessing there from Pastor Bill. I'll take that.

I am Dan McCollam. Dano is my kind of nickname here, but I have been in the Bethel stream for almost 30 years now. We are in this area. We are linked to you guys in friendship. I'm also co-founder of the Bethel School of the Prophets and the Prophetic Company. It's my honor to share with you guys today.

When I asked the Lord who he wanted to be for you this year as a community, I heard the word, "kinsman redeemer." I wasn't quite sure what he meant by that till I heard Bill just now. I felt like it was really connected to what Bill just said about how when Job prayed for his friends, when he prayed for the people that were hard to pray for, there was a double-portion that was poured out.

That reminded me of a passage that the Lord gave me for you, which was Isaiah 61, just the first couple of verses. Of course, this was the mandate of Jesus. When he sat in the Messiah chair in the synagogue, he said, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he's anointed me to preach good news to the poor and to bind up the brokenhearted." He kind of goes through a list in those first three verses. I was very much drawn to that.

I feel like the tangible anointing is going to increase in proportion to how we go to the poor, the broken, the outcast. So again, it links in to what Pastor Bill was just sharing. Just be aware of that. Just keep your heart and your eyes open to that. I felt like the Lord was saying that this was going to be a year of fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit, especially people being baptized in the Holy Spirit. I saw a move of people being baptized in the Holy Spirit and it kind of becoming like a reputation: that people would come here, hungry for the Lord, to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

I was also reminded of the great revivalist, Charles Grandison Finney and the Businessman's Revival, where over a hundred thousand people were swept into the kingdom of God in New York City through a prayer movement. He said this during that time: Whenever I see that my words are not having the power of conversion, I go into my closet and I seek a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit.



Not only did I see that this place became a reputation for a place to encounter the Holy Spirit, but also to be baptized and clothed with the power of the Holy Spirit. I also saw that there were going to be fresh baptisms of power, and that people who had felt like, “Wow, I used to see more happen in my life,” or “there used to be a greater fire, a greater impact,”... there was going to be a fresh baptism that came upon you to reignite that in the Spirit of what Charles Grandison Finney carried. So I bless you in the name of the Lord.

So if you want be baptized in the Holy Spirit, receive a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit, yeah. The word is now. The word is now, it's right now.

Lord, by your word, we receive a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit that clothes us in fresh power and fresh authority, that reignites the fire of heaven. Lord, I thank you that it's a baptism of the Holy Spirit and in fire. The fire is the fire of passion. The fire is the fire of zeal. The fire is the fire of love and compassion. Lord, we receive it now in Jesus' name.

So, Lord, we thank you for that. Jesus, we thank you that you sent this from your ascended throne, that you sent the outpouring of the Holy Spirit to clothe believers with the power to be witnesses with the power of signs and wonders and miracles with the power of intimate relationship with you. We receive that fresh outpouring. More Lord. Thank you, Lord.

I'm aware of some angelic activity in the room, too. Angels are actually handing out assignments right now. Some of you have been crying out for direction, you've said over and over again, “Lord, what do you want me to do?” There are angels that have been commissioned into this room to drop assignments into your heart, into your spirit. So if that's you that's really been crying out for that, just open your heart, open your spirit right now. There's going to be a divine unfolding in that area. Wow. Amen.

Part 2

I was looking at this painting over here — the eagle painting — and I was noticing how many colors were used in the painting. The painting is the eagle bringing the clock, symbolizing the question, “What is the time? What is the season? But it's like, what colors resonated with you? What words resonated with you? Begin to engage with those — pray, declare them, and also strategize with them. I'd really encourage you.

Well, the Lord gave me two quick words.



The first is that Bethel is coming into the fruit of perseverance. There are a lot of things you've been persevering through that are now beginning to manifest the fruit of being fully equipped and furnished for every good work that God has purposed for you. That is a really rich reward, and I just encourage you to step into it.

The second word has to do with your home. I do know a little bit about your home [Joaquin and Renée] — that you guys bought a house, and then there was the flood, and all that kind of stuff, and you've been displaced. There is often a parallel between what God is doing in the senior leader's house and in the church house. I was drawn to that parallel — that you guys are about to step into something greater than what you left. And there was that word, "The glory of the latter house will be greater than the glory of the former." That promise of the glory.

I also believe that there have been some great times for Bethel Austin. There have also been challenging times — rough and even disruptive times — much like what has gone on with your house and even a sense of being unsettled.

In the same way that you are about to come into a greater house, more suited for you, and that there will be a settling and a planting of the Lord, I believe that's going to be experienced within this congregation as well.

As we step into the greater glory, there will also be a sense of home, a sense of settling, a sense of family, and a sense of the planting of the Lord. Wow. Yeah. Bless you.
