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Hi, Bethel Austin family. Haley Braun here. So fun to be able to reach out to you guys. I feel so blessed to be able to do this. It's been exciting to hear what God is doing in and through the life of your church, and how He's breathing upon each of you. And I'm really excited for this coming season.

You know, we've been prophesying and speaking into a new era. You know that started in 2024. And I really believe we have entered into that new era. We're right at the beginning stages, and God is about to do some incredible things. Just a few weeks ago, as I was praying, I felt the Lord tell me that we're in a season of sovereign invitation that is not simply a sovereign move, but it is a sovereign invitation for the people of God to partner with what the Lord is saying and doing.

I was seeing in the spirit, seeing the airwaves just full of the voice of the Lord, full of the declarations of heaven. And the Lord keeps saying, "Those who have eyes to see and ears to hear, let them hear, let them see what God is saying right now to the church."

I believe we're in a season of great reformation. And as I was praying for you guys specifically, I just kept hearing the Lord say that, "This is my resting place. This is my prepared place." It's that they believe that it is the manifest Presence of God that transforms lives. And those lives transformed by the Presence of God is what changes the world. I do believe we are in a big season of reformation. We're going to see many things reformed in cities and nations. But what it comes down to, at the at the crux of the matter, is that what really reforms is a life that is been reformed and transformed by the Lord.

As I was praying for you guys, I just saw your sanctuary filled with the glory of God. I saw the Presence of the Lord resting in such a tangible and marked way. I see hours in the Presence of God. Evening services. Evening prayer meetings. I'm not sure if you have a midweek prayer meeting, but I feel like there's some kind of midweek prayer meeting where the Lord is going to have you guys pursue doing and praying, and all of a sudden the glory is going to come and it's going to be hours in the Presence of God.



And what I see happen in this time is two things. I see the goodness, the mercy, and the grace of God being revealed to the church, the identity of us as sons and daughters of a good Father. Romans 4 speaks about the Spirit of adoption by which we cry out, Abba, Father! But then I also see this Isaiah 11 moment, where it talks about the Holy Spirit resting on Jesus. It speaks about these manifestations of the Spirit, which is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, of counsel and of might, of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. And what I see is in that, that final one, it says in verse three of Isaiah 11, and in the fear of the Lord, He took delight talking about Jesus. I see us receiving the delight of the Lord, the goodness, the mercy, and the grace of the Father. And I see us delighting in the awe and the fear of God, because when we know the love of God, we understand the fear of the Lord.

And I believe that we're going to see a move of holiness. I believe specifically for you, Bethel Austin, is going to be a move of miracles, signs, and wonders as well. I see young people lingering in the presence, encountering the Lord and in that place receiving their heavenly identity, but beginning to walk in power and authority.

I see some of our moms and dads and grandparents beginning to mentor young people. But what I also see is fresh encounters for those that have experienced before and for those hungry for their first time encounter. I see these mothers and fathers rising up to establish the safe space for young people to get ignited, and I feel it will be radical, a radical igniting, for a harvest of souls.

But I see this, this graceful miracle, signs, and wonders. I see it starting in the church, but I see the church going out into the streets, and I see a wave of evangelism coming, onto the church as they are filled with the boldness, as Peter and John were in Acts 3 and Acts 4, as they were filled with boldness to declare the goodness of God.

Oh, and as I do that, I just begin to drink of God's delight in me that he has made a way where there was no way that it is in my weakness.

His power is made perfect, that He fills fragile clay jars with His glory. I just want to remind you in all of this that it is His goodness that allows us to drink deep, to drink deep of all that Jesus has made available for us.
